**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Representations have been received from the Assistant Engineers and Junior Engineers for amendment to RRs for Group A posts for making provision for promotion to the post of Deputy Director instead of 10% promotion to the post of Assistant Executive Engineer from the feeder post of Assistant Engineer in line with the CPWD/MES.

The demand has been considered keeping in view of the UPSC's advice vide their letter No. F.No. 3/21(1)/2002-RR dated 29.05.2002 and Ministry of Urban Development, Central Engineering (Civil) Group 'A' Service Rules, 2012 and the sanctioned strength available in (Civil) issued by CPWD vide F.No. 9/1/2012-S&D/74 dated 13.02.2015. As per advise of UPSC, promotion to the post of Deputy Director are to be made from the next below feeder grade of Assistant Executive Engineer. In CPWD, the number of Assistant Executive Engineer is less compared to the post of Executive Engineer, whereas in this Directorate, number of posts in the cadre of Assistant Executive Engineer is more than the number of posts in Deputy Director. Further Service Rules of CPWD provides that only the officers in the grade of Assistant Engineer on the date of the notification of the rules and possessing Diploma in Engineering shall however, continue to be eligible on completion of nine years regular service for consideration to the post of Executive Engineer (Civil) limited to 33 1/3% vacancies arising in the grade on annual basis. This implies that Diploma Engineers will not be considered for promotion to Group A post.

Therefore, in view of the above, the request for providing provision for promotion to the post of Deputy Director from the feeder post of Assistant Engineer cannot be acceded to. However, in order to provide more promotional avenue, the percentage of promotion to the post of Assistant Executive Engineer from Assistant Engineers possessing Degree in Engineering is being proposed to be increased to 20% from the existing 10% subject to approval of the competent authority.

This issues with the approval of Director General.
