G. S. R. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Department of Lighthouses and Lightships (Group 'B' Technical posts) Recruitment Rules, 1994 in so far as they relate to the posts of Assistant Engineer (Electronics), Assistant Engineer (Electrical) and Assistant Engineer (Mechanical), Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships, 'Technician (Electronics)' Group "C" Posts Recruitment Rules 2007, Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships, Junior Engineer (Civil/Electrical/Mechanical) Group "C" Posts Recruitment Rules 2006, in so far as they relate to the posts of Junior Engineer (Electrical) and Junior Engineer (Mechanical), Department of Lighthouses and Lightships (Non-gazatted technical posts) Recruitment Rules, 1978 except as respects thing done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Engineer (Electronics/Electrical/Mechanical), Foreman Diesel Technician, Junior Engineer (Electrical/Mechanical) and Technician (Electronics/Electrical/Diesel/General) in the Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement-** (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Shipping, Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships (Group "B" & "C" Technical Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of post, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale.-** The number of said post, its classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.-** The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification-** No person,-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax. -** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.-** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit, and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
