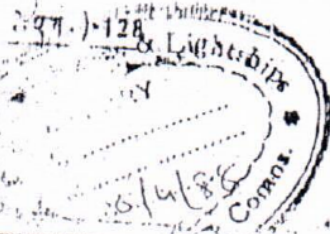

राष्ट्रपति, संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 के अन्तर्गत प्रवृत्त पदों का प्रयोग करते हुए और 1979 के उन बातों के सिवाए अधिनीत करते हुए जिनमें ऐसे अधिकांश पदों के लिए नियमित नियम लागू हैं, अर्थात्—

- 1. अधिनीत नाम और प्रारंभ:—(1) इन नियमों का अधिनीत नाम 'रीपब्लिक और रीपब्लिक विभाग (भारत सरकार के अधिकांश पदों पर पदों की पदवृत्ति, आदि) नियम, 1988' होगा।
- (2) ये नियम प्रकाशन की तारीख की प्रवृत्त होंगे।
- 2. नाम:—ये नियम संसदे उपासक अनुसूची के अन्तर्गत 1 में विनिर्दिष्ट पदों को लागू होंगे।
- 3. पद-संख्या, वर्गीकरण और वेतनमान:—उक्त पदों की संख्या, उनका वर्गीकरण और उनके वेतनमान वे होंगे जो उक्त अनुसूची के अन्तर्गत 2 में स्तम्भ 1 में विनिर्दिष्ट हैं।
- 4. पदों की पदवृत्ति, आय-सीमा और अन्य शर्तें आदि:—उक्त पदों पर पदों की पदवृत्ति, आय-सीमा शर्तें और उनके संबंधित अन्य शर्तें वे होंगी जो उक्त अनुसूची के अन्तर्गत 5 में विनिर्दिष्ट हैं।

G.S.R. 119.—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Department of Lighthouses and Lightships (Non-Gazetted Lighthouse Personnel) Recruitment Rules, 1979 except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession; the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of non-gazetted lighthouse personnel in the Department of Lighthouses and Lightships, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Department of Lighthouses and Lightships (Non-Gazetted Lighthouse Personnel) Recruitment Rules, 1988.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Number of posts, classification and scales of pay.—The number of said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit, and other qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, quali-

fications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the Schedule.

5. Disqualification.—No person,—
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
  - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
 shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard:—
