G. S. R. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships, (Group 'A' Gazetted, Technical Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2002 for the post of Director General, Deputy Director General and Assistant Executive Engineer (Electronics/ Civil/Mechanical), in so far as they relate to the posts of Assistant Executive Engineer (Electronics/ Civil/Mechanical) except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Assistant Executive Engineer (Electronics/ Civil/Mechanical) in the Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**-(i) These rules may be called the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Directorate General of Lighthouses and Lightships (Group 'Technical Posts), Assistant Executive Engineer (Electronics/Civil/Mechanical) Recruitment Rules, 2026.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Application.** - These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of posts, classification, Level in the pay matrix.** - The number of posts, their classification, level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.**- The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

5. **Disqualification.** -No person, -
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

Shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Saving.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect relaxation, relaxation of age-limit, and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

"Experience in general administration, maintenance and operation of Lighthouses or other aids to marine navigation or construction/maintenance of high rise structures near shore."

Category Mechanical:

Essential:

(i) Degree in Mechanical Engineering from a recognised University.

(ii) Two years' experience in a supervisory capacity in installation/ production/maintenance/R&D of engines/machineries.

Desirable:

Experience in Ship construction/repair industry.

Note 1.- Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission for reason to be recorded in writing, in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.

Note 2.- The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission for reasons to be recorded in writing in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, if at any stage of selection the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.
